Coming from Delta-At the corner of 176th Street and 64th take then # 10 Hgwy to Cloverdale. Turn left onto 176. Turn right onto 64th Ave. Follow about 2 blocks. Club on the right hand side.

Coming from Langley take Langley Bypass to Fraser Hgwy. Turn right onto Fraser Hgwy. Follow to 64th Ave. Turn left onto 64th Ave. Follow to Cloverdale Horseshoe Club on your left hand side(if you get to McDonalds you have gone to far)

Coming from Abbotsford take #1 Hgwy to 176 St Exit. Take 176 St to 64th Ave. Turn left onto 64th Ave. Follow about 2 blocks. Club on the right hand side.
